

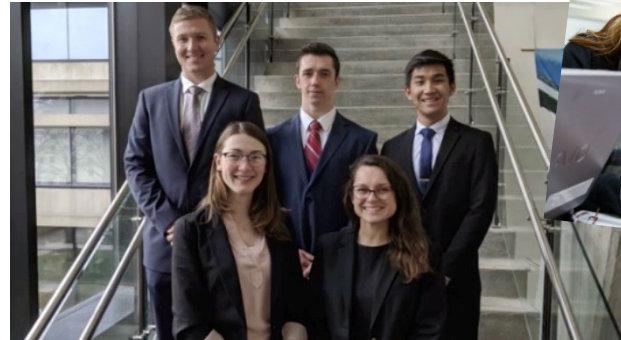

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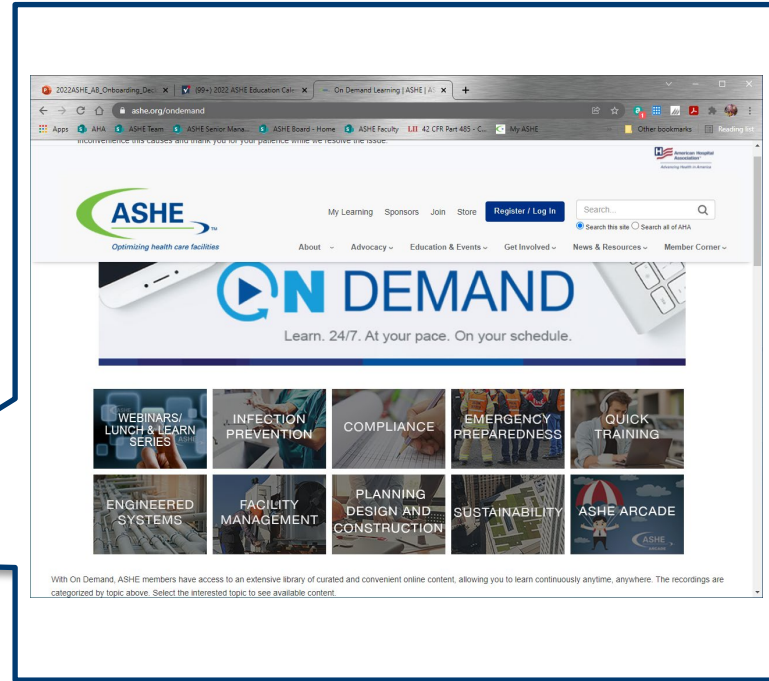
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New Programs for 2022

Project Firstline

- Ventilation Assessment Tool: Provides clinicians with information to start or to help with conversations with their Facilities Managers as they work together to improve air quality and reduce the spread of infection
- Tool is based on CDC, FGI guidance around ventilation requirements (but don't forget to check results against other adopted codes for compliance)
- Within the search function, you can obtain:
 - Air change per hour
 - Outdoor air change per hour
 - Room pressurization
 - Air exhaust to outdoors
 - Air recirculation
